

The Model 105L5 is an ultra high capacity plier style resistance soldering system. It comes pre-assembled for your convenience.

This set is designed for applications such as thin walled copper tubing up to 1/2", large military connectors, or other heavy duty applications where more critical control of intense heat is required, like large scale rebuilds or operations involving significant heat sinks.



Model 105L5

Resistance heat is obtained by passing a safe, low voltage, high amperage current through a resistive alloy. As with all Resistance Soldering Handpieces, heat is generated locally to the handpiece. Current is present for only so long as power is applied to the handpiece and there is a path for the current from the power unit, through the handpiece and back to the power unit.
