



The Model 10501 is a light capacity tweezer style resistance soldering system. It comes pre-assembled for your convenience.

This set is designed to provide immediate concentrated heat to create accurate, trustworthy solder joints in delicate soldering applications. Ideal for use on the smallest of components, this system is powered by a low-voltage, high amperage, AC current power supply and controlled by a footswitch.



Model 10501

Resistance heat is obtained by passing a safe, low voltage, high amperage current through a resistive alloy. As with all Resistance Soldering Handpieces, heat is generated locally to the handpiece. Current is present for only so long as power is applied to the handpiece and there is a path for the current from the power unit, through the handpiece and back to the power unit.

- **105A3** - Variable AC current power unit
- **10519** - Footswitch
- **10542** - Copper clad stainless steel electrodes, 5/64" diameter

- 100W (2.65VAC) power unit with variable output control, pilot light, 1 AMP circuit protection and heavy-duty aluminum case
- Durable, user-friendly hand piece with four foot (1.22m) AWG 14-2 HPN cord set
- Electrodes constructed of 1-1/2" (38.1mm) stainless steel
- Rugged, industrial footswitch with 6 foot (1.83m), three-wire cord and NEMA 5-15 P/R piggyback plug

NOTE: The power unit has been rated to operate at a 50% maximum duty cycle. Do not operate beyond this rating.
